

ORDINANCE 11-110.2

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF
MAGISTERIAL/JUSTICES OF THE PEACE DISTRICTS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 67.045, the County is required to redistrict in accordance with the current census information; and,

WHEREAS, the total population of McLean County, as listed in the 2010 Census is 9,531, and


WHEREAS, in order to achieve the division of McLean County into compact, contiguous, and equal population as reasonably possible, the number of magisterial districts shall remain four (4), with no changes to the existing boundaries.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the four (4) magisterial districts of McLean County shall have the following boundaries:

REAPPORTIONMENT PUBLIC NOTICE:

In accordance with the provisions of KRS 67.045, the Fiscal Court of the County of **McLean**, Kentucky hereby gives notice of the procedures to be followed in the planned reapportionment of the commissioners' districts:

The Fiscal Court shall, at a meeting on the 24 day of May, 2011, appoint three (3) competent citizens of the County, over age of twenty-one (21) and residing in different districts, and the County Clerk as a nonvoting member, to serve as Reapportionment Commissioners, whose duty shall be to lay the County off into not less than three (3) nor more than eight (8) districts.

The Reapportionment Commissioners shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of their appointment, lay off the boundary lines of the districts in accordance with the provisions of KRS 67.045 and submit their written Report, showing the boundary of each district and the estimated population in each, to the County Clerk and the members of the Fiscal Court.

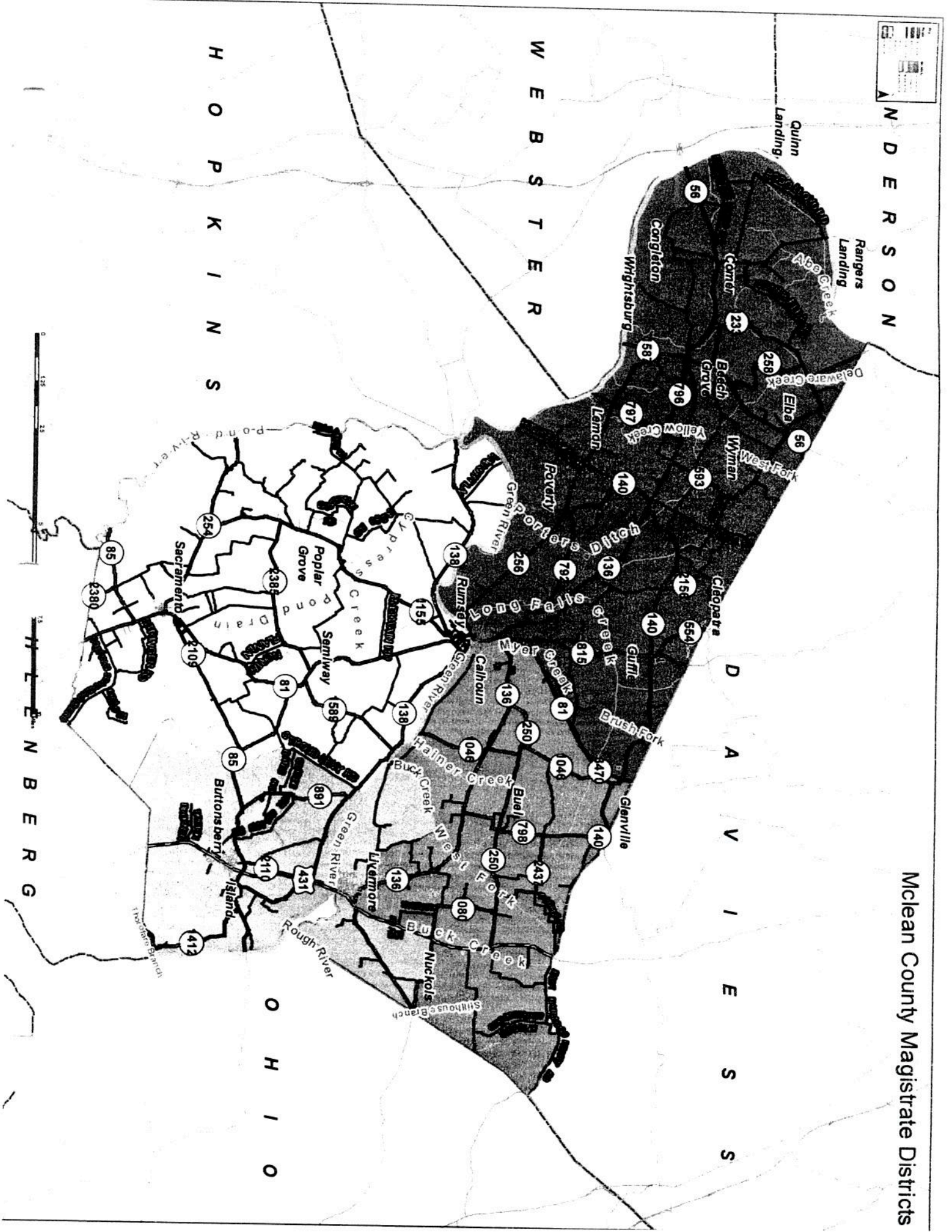
The Fiscal Court shall, within (60) days after receipt of the Reapportionment Commissioners' Report, consider the Report and either adopt or amend the Report.

Any registered voter of the County may, within twenty (20) days of the establishment of the districts by the Fiscal Court, bring an action in **McLean** County Circuit Court to enforce the provisions of KRS.67.045.
